2004-09-03	foundation of EAA in Eberswalde founding members:	- Eberswalde-Finow (Germany) - Glasgow-Prestwick (Scotland) - Györ-Per (Hungary) - Karlovy Vary (Czech Rep.) - Kaunas (Lithuania) - Vojens
2004-11-05	Two days visit of Representatives from Eberswalde and Györ in Budapest to arrange and prepare a business convention for regional entrepreneurs and political bodies, initiated by the EAA	
2005-03-09	Upon EAA invitation Three days convention for regional politicians and entrepreneurs in Györ has been hold with 5 workshops: Infrastructure (airport, port), Renewable Energy, Industrial Production, European Education and Trading Relations	
2005-11-02	3 days meeting with partners of the EUROPLANE project under the European InterReg III program	

- European InterReg III program Decision to participate in this project (Eberswalde-Barnim and Kaunas out of the EAA members), not yet confirmed by the EU-commission Thereafter several months preparing the project content
- 2006-03-29 3 days EUROPLANE kick-off meeting in Potsdam, Germany preparation of the workgroups and structuring the subjects



- 2006-09-13 3 days EUROPLANE workshop meeting at Genoa, Italy Eberswalde and Kaunas were mainly interested in passenger potential analyses and forecast
- 2006-11-03 3 days EUROPLANE workshop meeting at Waterford, Ireland
- 2007-02-09 1 day EUROPLANE presentation meeting in Poznan, Poland
- 2007-04-17 3 days EUROPLANE workshop meeting at Kaunas, Lithuania The first results of the passenger potential analyses are presented for six airports: Ancona, Aosta, Eberswalde-Finow, Genoa, Poznan and Waterford
- 2007-08-30 2 days EUROPLANE workshop meeting at Aosta Valley, Italy Final discussion of the passenger potential analyses and draft of a resolution to the EU-Commission in regard to the development of regional airports
- 2007-10-04 2 days EUROPLANE final conference at Bruges, Belgium Resolution to the Commission of the European Union, DG TREN, is finally agreed, signed by 11 European political bodies engaged in EUROPLANE and send to the Commission on 2007-10-30
- 2007-11-15 2 days handover meeting EUROPLANE / EUROBIRD at Bremen, Germany The next project planned is EUROBIRD (InterReg IV C), supposed to use certain results and experiences from the EUROPLANE project
- 2008-01-28 EAA and IDRF (see <u>www.idrf.aero</u>) agree on a co-operation to gain acceptance and influence in the rulemaking processes at the EASA (European Aviation Safety Agency)
- 2008-02-13 2 days additional workshop meeting at Eberswalde, Germany Using remaining funds from the original subjects under the EUROPLANE project we were able to develop a Content Management System (CMS) for small airport websites. This CMS may be used by all EAA-members, as EAA was one of the development partners.
